The learning center began with the mission to provide comprehensive, full-time special education and therapeutic support to children with diverse needs including Autism, ADHD, Learning Disabilities, Intellectual Disability, Slow Learning, and Physical Disabilities.

The Need

- **2.11 million** children with special needs (CWSN) are enrolled in school - just **0.85%** of total enrolment.
- **Attendance:** 61% for CWSN vs. 71% for other children.
- **Secondary education completion:** Only **9–10%** of children with disabilities.
- **Inclusive infrastructure:** About **40%** of schools still lack basic accessibility features.

WHY KUSHAAGRA MATTERS!



The KUSHAAGRA Learning Centre was established with the mission to provide comprehensive, full-time special education and therapeutic support to children with diverse needs including autism, ADHD, learning disabilities, intellectual disabilities, slow learning, and physical disabilities.

Subjects Taught: English, Mathematics, and Environmental Studies (EVS)

Therapies: Regular physiotherapy and occupational therapy sessions

Additional Support: Online remedial classes for personalized learning

Age Group: 6–13 years (inclusive)

The centre nurtures holistic development; fostering logical, social, emotional, and communication skills while encouraging independence through art, craft, and celebrations.

By bridging education and therapy, it creates an inclusive space where learning and joy go hand in hand, empowering children to grow into confident, independent, and self-aware individuals.
